

# How To Search with SeedsSearch<sup>AI</sup>

Enter search keyword in the search window and click [ Search ] (select a university if necessary)

**! POINT !**

- No name, affiliation, or text search
- One search keyword is recommended

When multiple words are entered, the search is basically performed as an OR search. However, if they are recognized by Azure as a single phrase, the results may be similar to an AND search.

Select the word you need to display the search results from the suggested related words.

**! POINT !**

Related words are extracted from Wikipedia as a dictionary. If there is no search keyword, no related words are presented.

Select [ Display ] or [ Refine ]

Display = Go to section

–First 5 researchers are displayed in order of relevance

Refine = Go to section ⑤

–Refine your search results

**! POINT !**

You can also select “Refine” after displaying the search results ⑤


How to interpret results

- Show Detail = Click to display of up to 10 related achievements
- Link to researcher's further info page
  - Researcher Profiles = University official personal page (Nagoya University only)
  - researchmap = “researchmap” personal page (Gifu University only)
  - Lab/Personal Website\* = Lab pages, etc.
  - Related info\* = Article or video introducing the researcher, etc.

\* Displayed only for the applicable researcher



# How To Search with SeedsSearch<sup>+</sup>AI

Select a refinement method and follow the instructions for each



**Related Word Filter:**  
Exclude unnecessary related words and narrow down the results

**AND SEARCH:**  
Search for a new search keyword and display researchers related to both the new and original search keywords. (Results are displayed in order of relevance of the last search term)
