

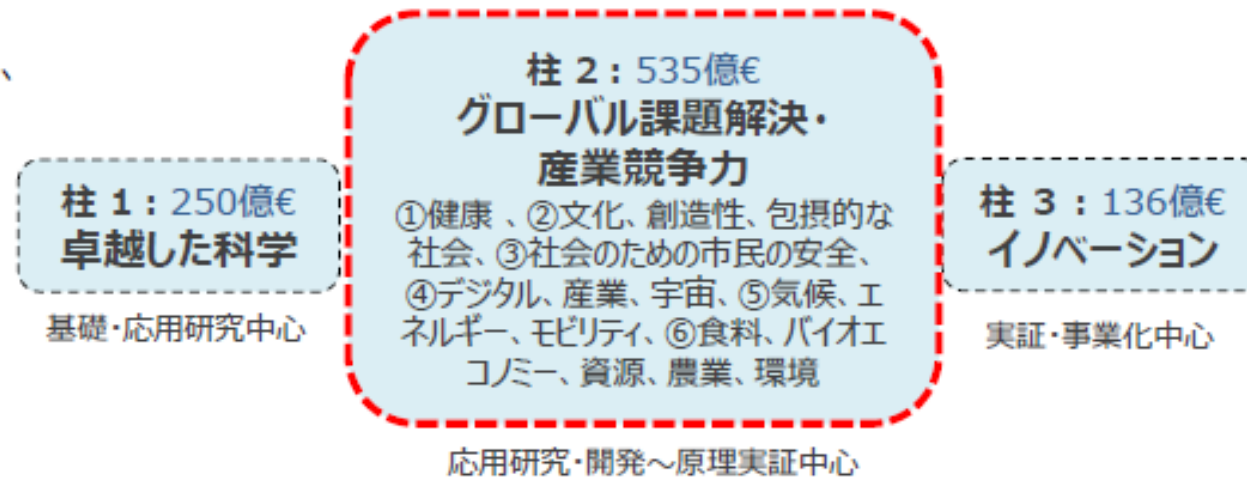
## EUの研究開発支援枠組み「ホライズン・ヨーロッパ」(HE)への準参加

- ✓ ホライズン・ヨーロッパとは、気候変動への対応、SDGs達成への貢献、競争力・成長の促進等を目標とするEUによる7か年の研究開発支援枠組み（2021年～2027年）で総予算は955億€（＝約15兆円規模）。
- ✓ 3つの柱から構成されるプログラム等を通じて目標達成を目指す、世界最大規模の公募研究開発プロジェクト

### 1. ホライズン・ヨーロッパへの準参加

- ◆ EU構成国以外の国にも「準参加」の途が開かれており、日本は2024年12月にそのための協定交渉を開始。
- ◆ 2025年12月現在、NZ、英国、カナダ、韓国を含む22か国・地域が準参加。
- ◆ 準参加国は、EUへの拠出金が必要。日本は令和8年度予算として内閣府が約11.8億円を要求。

※1: 3つの柱の他に「欧州研究圏（ERA）拡大の取組（34億€）」がある

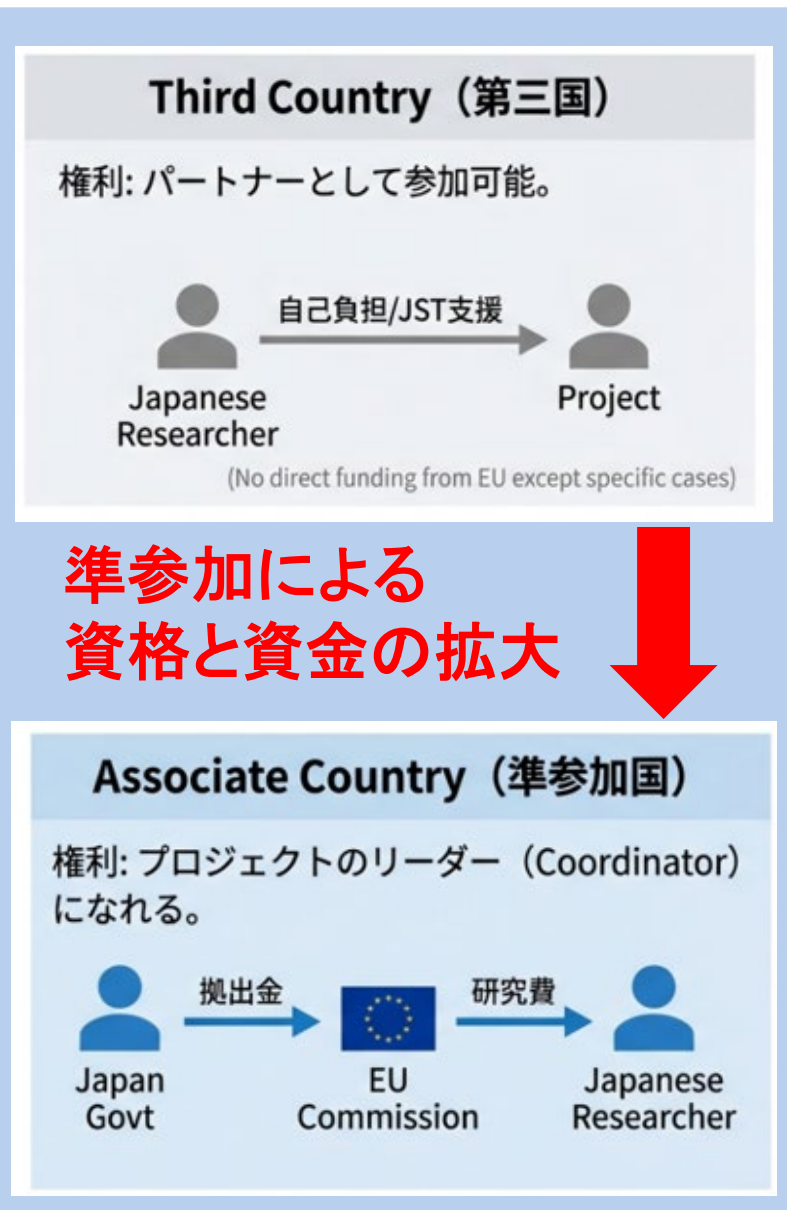
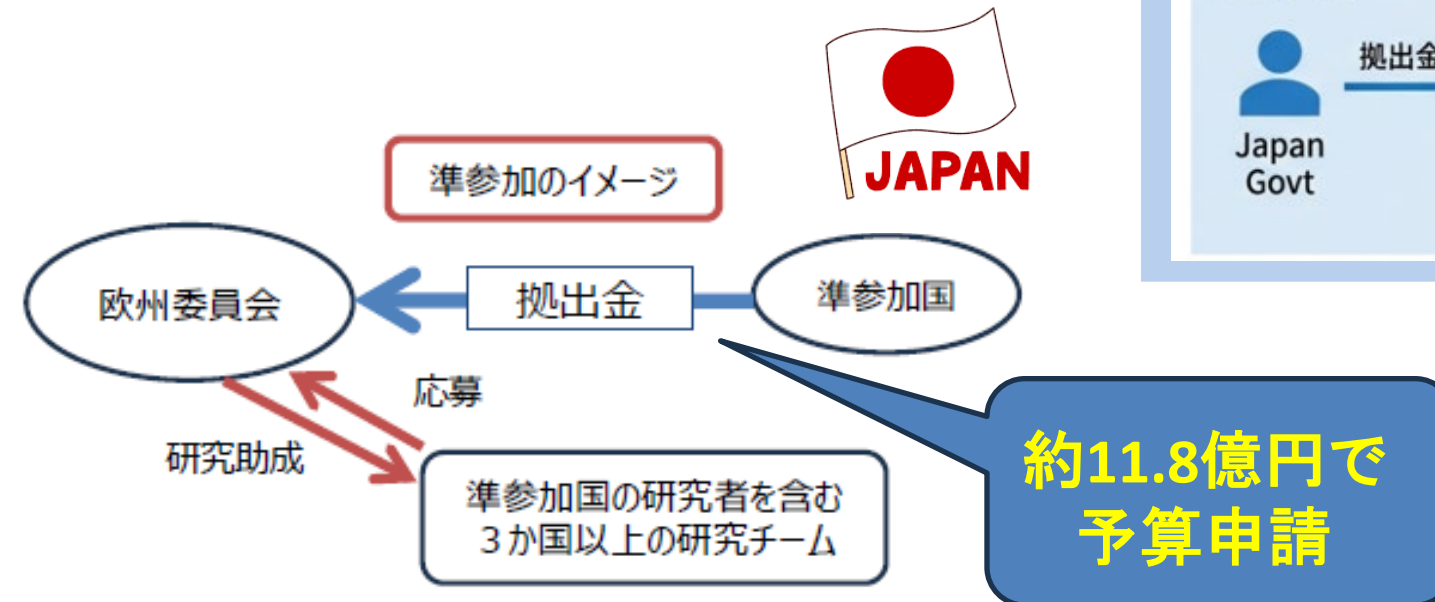


### 2. 我が国の準参加の意義

- ◆ EU加盟国等との国際的な科学技術・イノベーション協力が活発化し、質の高い論文の増加、研究者の国際流動性向上、企業や研究機関等の世界最先端の研究への参画促進といった多面的な効果が生まれる。
- ◆ この効果により、ひいては、我が国の研究力向上、産業競争力の強化、国際ネットワークの強化に繋がることが期待される。

### 3. 今後のスケジュール

- ◆ 12月22日に協定案につき実質合意し、2026年度予算成立以降の署名を目指している。

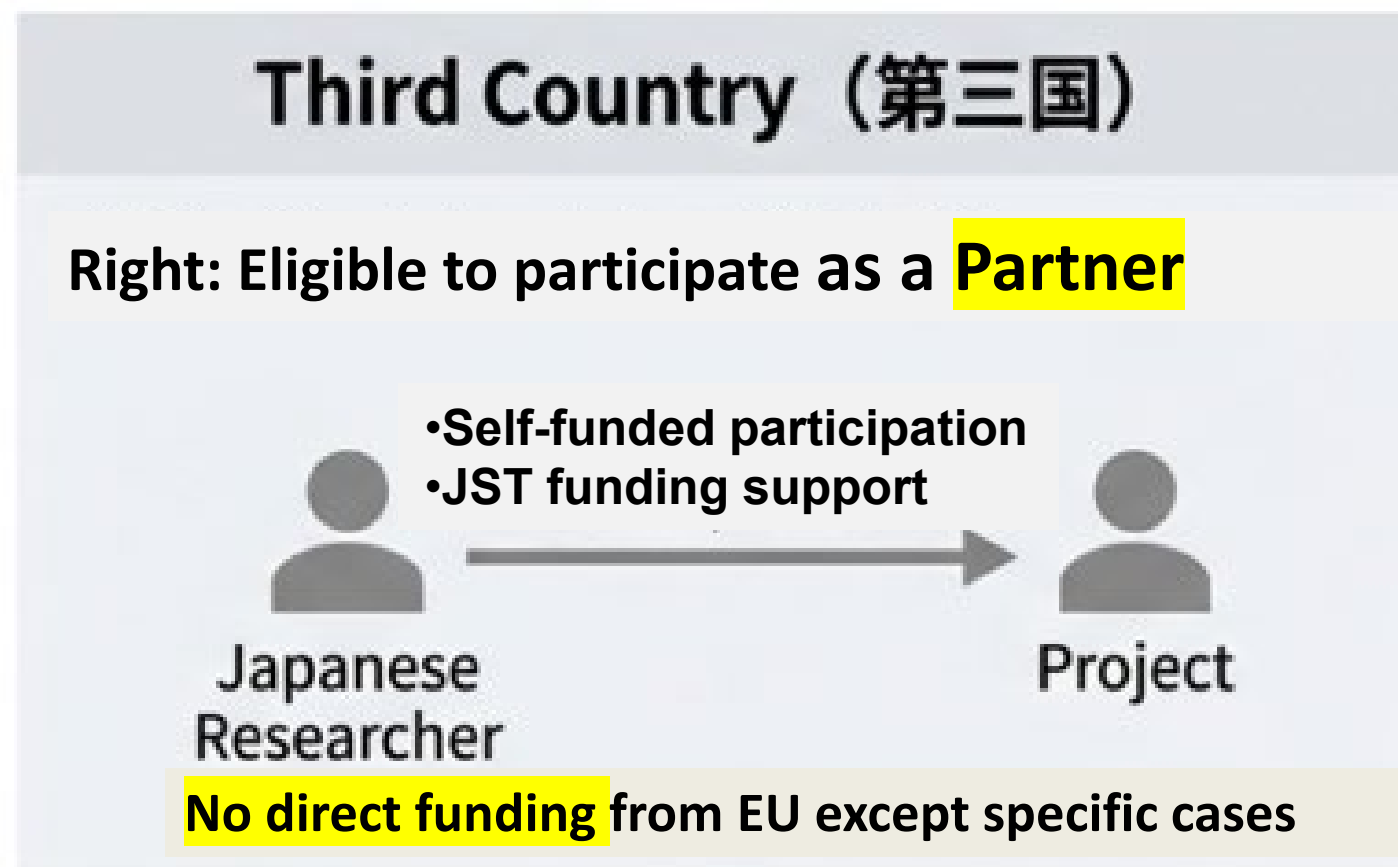
